**ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR
NOTIFICATION**

No.FEB.62/2021/1(0/0): In pursuance of Clause 3 of Article 166 of the Constitution of India and all powers enabling in this behalf, the Governor of Assam is pleased to direct that the following powers shall be delegated to DCs and chairman of DDMA to issue sanction against admissible assistance under SDRF for Agriculture, Animal & Husbandry, Handloom, Fishery, Sericulture etc. and Minor repairing of infrastructure like Primary School, Primary Health Centre, Electric Pool and Wires and Panchayat Ghar, Anganwadi Centre, Mahila Mandal, Yova Kenda/Community Hall under Schedule-III of Delegation of Financial Powers Rules, 1999 (as amended).
